Transport from/ to school

Your hotels will be in Sliema, which is not far from Msida (where the College is) and mid-way to Valletta (the Capital). To give you an idea of distances, it takes approx. 20 – 25 min by bus from Sliema to Valletta and around 15 mins from Sliema to Msida.

Monday and Tuesday we will be together, where Monday we will take you to Valletta, so you may choose to go around Sliema/ St Julians and enjoy the beach, for those who get here early.

The guests staying at the Carlton Hotel will be picked up in the morning (8.15 hrs) on Mon/ Tue as it is on the way.

Sliema / St. Julians Area (Hotel)

Your hotel is centrally located, minutes away from the entertainment area (St. Julians / Spinola Bay) and the Sliema shopping area. Shops in Malta are open till 7pm

You may reach the shopping area by walking on the promenade direction Sliema-Centre.

There are plenty of restaurants and bars around this area, some of the best being just round the corner. e.g. Piccolo padre (almost opposite the hotel), Vecchia Napoli (a good pizzeria) and the restaurants at Balluta Bay.
